EXPECTATIONS:**1) Looking after myself and others.**

- I will only use my designated log-in details and never share them with anyone.
- I will not set-up or use any personal email accounts on my school device.
- I will not sign-in to any personal social media accounts on my school device.
- I will ask for help from my teacher or responsible adult, before clicking if I am unsure about a 'pop-up' or 'hyperlink'.
- I will not send or accept an Airdrop unless it has been specifically approved by my teacher.
- I will not reveal any personal details about myself or others online.
- I will tell my teacher or other staff member if I see or hear something that makes me uncomfortable or worried.
- I will not tamper with, or try to access, iPads belonging to others.
- I will not take photographs or videos of others without their consent.
- I will not use my device to create, access, store or distribute inappropriate content.
- I will not use my iPad to share, post or store images, video or audio without the consent of the individuals in the images/recordings.

2) Looking after my iPad.

- I will keep my iPad in its protective case at all times.
- I will treat all devices with care.
- I will ensure that my battery is charged and device is ready for use each day.
- I will keep my iPad safe by always putting it in the locked storage between uses.
- I will report it immediately if my device is stolen, lost or damaged.
- I will never try to fix or clean my iPad by myself.

3) Being respectful.

- I will close my iPad and put it down when an adult is talking to me.
- I will only use my iPad when directed by my teacher or responsible adult to do so.
- I will never use my iPad to hurt, shame, or intimidate others and I will tell a responsible adult if anyone else is doing so.
