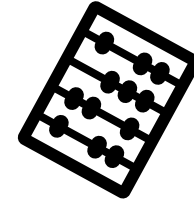
In what order should I begin learning my times tables?

It is up to you, but we recommend doing the yellow tables **first**, and the green tables **next** before **finally**, the blue tables. You can begin learning tables as soon as you can add numbers together comfortably.

It takes most children all of primary school to learn them all, so don't panic!

Bronze Award -

Say a times table from start to finish with no mistakes!

Silver Award -

Be able to answer questions from a times table in a mixed up order. For example, what is 6×3 ?, what is 6×9 ? And so on.

Gold Award -

Be able to give the times table question based on an answer. For example, the answer is 35, so you would say 5×7 .

Platinum Award -

Know your times tables as both multiplication and division facts. For example, $56 \div 8 = 7$.
